## Hall Rotary Club donate \$5000 to Grenfell Community Health Services

An extraordinarily generous gesture has been made to the Grenfell community by the Rotary Club of Hall (ACT).

At the Grenfell Rotary Club's Sept 24 meeting, President of the Hall Club, Clive Badelow presented a cheque for \$5,000 to Grenfell Community Health Services Manager, Lynne Peterson for the purchase of items specifically for the use of the Grenfell community.

Along with Clive, Tony Howard (Past Director of Farmers Markets), Bill Pearson (Club Service Director and past Grenfellite) and Colleen Ebsworth (Community Service) travelled to Grenfell especially to make the presentation.

The link to Grenfell came about after Grenfell local, Ann Vicary spoke with one of the Hall members (at the Capital Markets in the ACT, where Ann is a regular) about the need for equip-

ment for our health services.

After liaising with Lynne Peterson, a list of items to be purchased was formulated and includes a palliative care bed, portable baby scales with carry bag and measuring tape, and a marquee for outdoor uses.

At the request of both Rotary Clubs, a condition of the purchase and presentation of these items to the community is that they must remain the property of Grenfell and not to leave the town.

The visit between the two Clubs and the presentation was arranged by Past President Chris Lobb.

The Hall members were guests at the Grenfell meeting and stayed overnight at Pam Livingstone's B&B.
